1. Log in to the iTRACK website:

2. Under the 'KS1-KS2' tab, click the 'Times Table Tests' sub-tab and then click 'Test Session'.
3. Here, you will find the test code and the assigned year group.
4. Make a note of the test code that you would like the pupil to complete.

Completing a Test

1. Go to the testing site:

<https://awl.itrackededucation.com/timesTableTests>

2. Enter the school code and test code.

3. Select their name from the list and click 'Start Test' .

4. The child will see instructions on how to complete the test.

5. Once they are ready, they will click 'Start Test' to begin.


Important Information about the Test:

Once logged in the text the Child will see this text:

'Students will be shown a question and they can click or tap on the number pad on screen to enter their answer, or press the numbers on their keyboard if they are using a PC/Mac.'

This test is timed. Children will have 3 minutes and 30 seconds to complete as many questions as they can. There are 35 questions in a test.

Press 'Start Test' to begin your test

Skipping Questions:

- Children cannot skip questions. Children will be sent to the next question automatically once the time for that question is up.

Reviewing Questions

- Once a question has timed out, Children are unable to revisit that same question unless they redo the whole test.

Submitting the Test:

- At the end, children must click 'Exit Test' to complete the test or close the browser.
- Once the test is completed, pupils will be told how many questions they answered correctly, they can then exit the programme.

Continuing a Test Later

- If the internet fails or pupils need a break during the test, children will need to retake the test as there is no way to pause a test.



Analysis Features

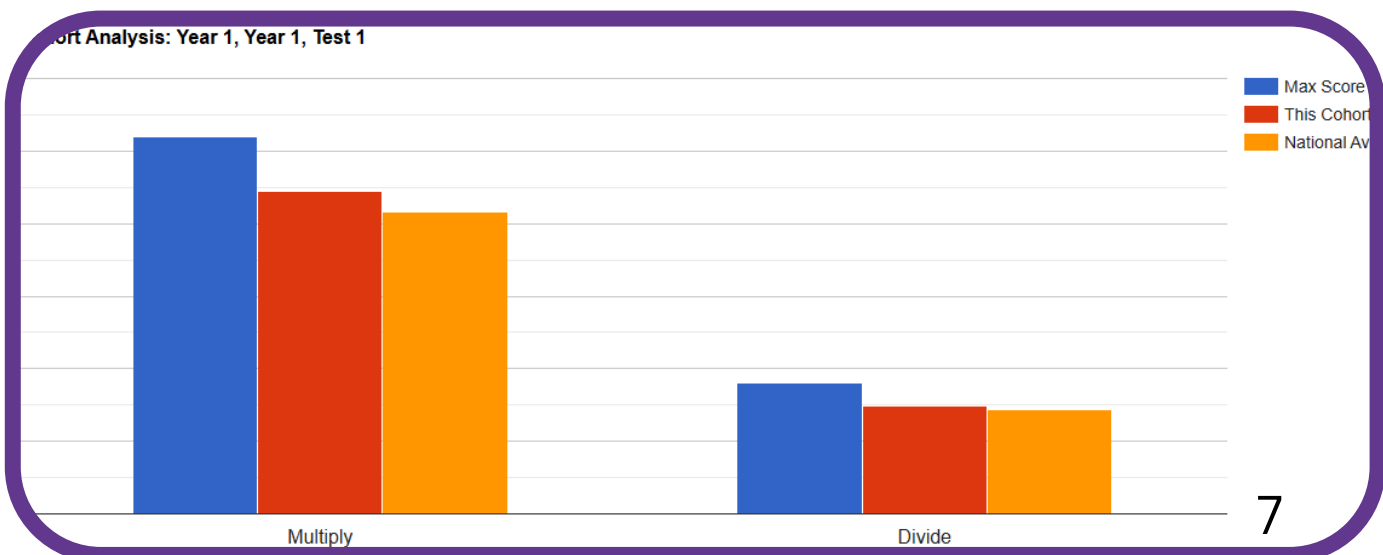
Test Results

Shows the percentage of correct answers for each test a pupil has taken.

If a pupil has taken the same test multiple times, it will show the most up-to-date score.

Cohort Analysis

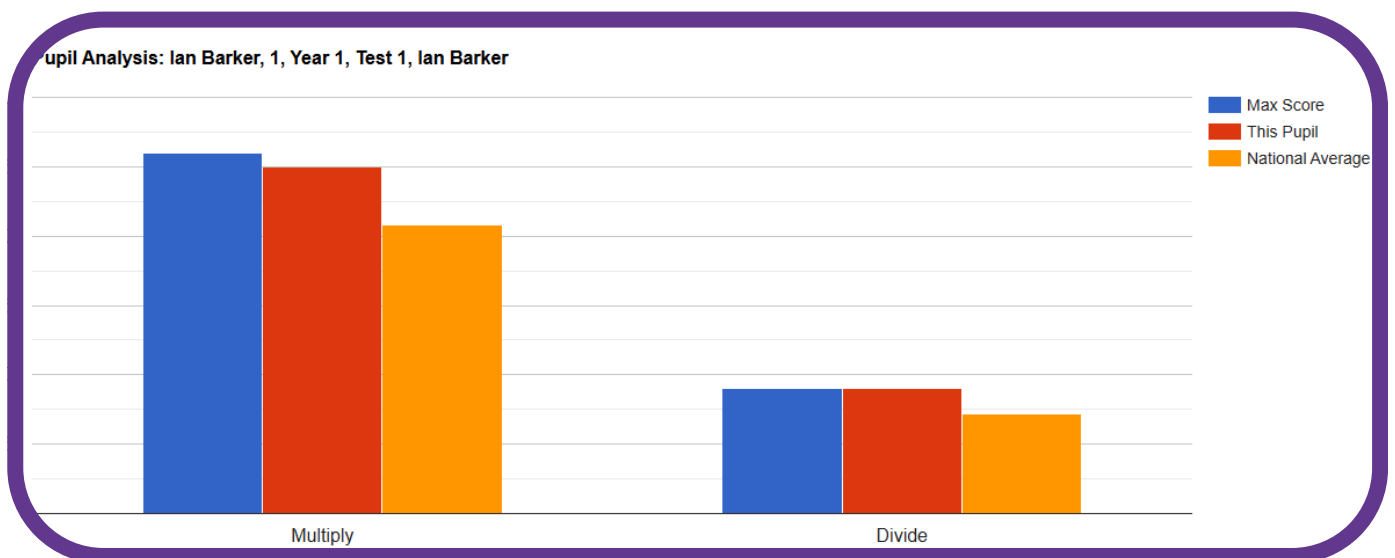
- Cohort analysis shows the total marks of the test on multiplication and division.
- The average score for multiply and divide across the cohort
- The average score from last year's multiplication check (National Average).
- A breakdown of the pupils' results based on multiply and divide questions



Analysis Features

Question Analysis

Shows the percentage of pupils who got each question correct on the test selected.



Pupil Analysis

Provides a breakdown of a specific child's answers to each question of the test .
